Tuition for the 2018-2019 school year is as follows:

Thank you for your interest in Geibel Catholic Junior-Senior High School. Provided, for your convenience, are the tuition rates for the 2018-2019 school year. These tuition rates do not reflect the actual cost of educating a student for one year at Geibel Catholic. For high school students, the cost is over \$12,100. For junior high students, the cost is more than \$6,000.
